UPDATED [Trust Reporting Rules for 2024](#)

New trust reporting rules were announced in 2023 – including the introduction of BARE trust arrangements. Filing of BARE trusts has been suspended for 2023 and 2024. All other trusts are still required to file a return for 2024.

Deadline for Filing a T3 Trust Return – March 31, 2025

If the trust is reporting capital gains income, the deadline is extended to May 1, 2025

Tax Planning for 2025 and Beyond

[Alternative Minimum Tax \(AMT\)](#) – Legislation Passed – Retroactive to January 1, 2024

- When AMT is higher than the calculated federal income tax, the larger amount is payable
- Expected to affect taxpayers with capital gains income in the highest tax bracket
- The difference between AMT paid and the calculated federal tax can reduce federal taxes in future years
- The changes could significantly impact tax planning, particularly for capital gains and large donations

[Canadian Entrepreneurs' Incentive](#) – Proposed Legislation – [Effective for 2025 Tax Year](#)

- Will reduce tax rate on capital gains on dispositions of qualifying shares by an eligible individual
- Inclusion rate of one-third on a life-time maximum of \$2 million in eligible capital gains
- Will apply in addition to the new life-time capital gains exception of \$1.25 million
- Several qualifications and exclusions to determine eligibility

[Canada Disability Benefit](#) – Legislation Passed – Regulations Drafted – Scheduled for July 2025

- \$200 per month for Canadian residents with disabilities
- Working age between 18 and 64 years old
- Must have a valid Disability Tax Credit certificate and have filed a tax return for the previous year
- Benefit is reduced based on income over \$23K if single and \$32.5K if married or common-law
- Apply through Service Canada when available

[Pharmacare Act](#) – Legislation Passed – Bilateral Agreements with Provinces to be Negotiated

- Universal access to contraception medications and devices
- Universal access to diabetes medications and devices
- Timing and delivery of the program will depend on each province or territory
